Phil dedicated himself to making sure his students stood out when it was their time to leave us. In our environment working one-on-one, in a tutorial capacity, is the preferred method of instruction. Phil could take a student, coming to us with a 2nd or 3rd grade math level, and within six months have him working a 7th or 8th grade level.
